Dressing Rooms:

There are six dressing rooms, all with hot and cold water, mirrors and lights, to comfortably accommodate a total of 21 people. Two showers are located opposite Dressing room 5. An adapted dressing room to accommodate one disabled person is available.

**Please advise all your company members
that dressing room doors must not be propped open.**

**Smoking is not allowed anywhere in the building (unless as part of stage business.)
Alcohol consumption is not allowed in any backstage area at any time.**

Laundry & Preparation Room

Our laundry has an automatic washing machine and tumble dryer. There is an iron and ironing board but we recommend that visiting companies bring their own. There is a kettle, fridge, microwave and washing-up facilities in the laundry room.

**Visiting companies are responsible for their own “housekeeping”
in the laundry room.**

SOUND

Operator's position:

Situated at the rear of the stalls or in the control room immediately behind, which has a removable window. Please advise us of any requirement to operate in the rear stalls as soon as possible, since this requires that certain seats remain unsold.

Control and effects:

Allen & Heath GL3 24 into 4 into 2 mixer

Samson SAD2500E graphic equalisers

Yamaha SPX 990 digital effects unit

Front of house:

Electrovoice P1250 amplifier, driving 4 Electrovoice Sx200 speakers mounted on the proscenium wall.

Stage:

Yamaha P2500 amplifiers, driving 4 Electrovoice Sx200 speakers via Speakon connectors: 4 on stage, 1 in the orchestra pit.

Stage-box:

Stage right, 20 ways. 10 of these ways are duplicated in a box on stage left and 10 are duplicated in the orchestra pit. Four tie-lines return to the control room from stage right.

Reproduction:

2 Sony MD110 minidisc player

1 Denon DCD685 CD player

1 Tascam CD160 CD player

1 Denon DRW585 cassette player

STAGE MANAGEMENT

Our prompt corner is downstage right. A prompt desk provides cue lights to pit, flys, seven points around the stage and the lighting and sound operators' positions.

A basic cctv monitor system relays the view from FOH to the prompt corner.

A Techpro headset system provides communication to the fly floor, stage left, lighting, sound and follow spot operators.

A small workshop / props room is available for basic maintenance.

**Please note that visiting companies are not allowed
to paint scenery on the stage.**

There is no dedicated company office, wireless internet access or telephone line.

A locker is available for the storage of guns and small items of value.
